1. Go to [www.google.com/cse](http://www.google.com/cse)
2. Click on [Create a Custom Search Engine](#)
3. Enter the following information:

- a. Name, Description
- b. Sites to Search
- c. Check the Terms of Service box.
- d. Click Next

List one URL per line.


4. Choose the Style
